Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) is an experience and a process designed to enable an individual to move from an experience of "church" to an experience of "being church for others". CRHP was developed in 1969, and has been implemented in over 500 parishes in twenty one states. CRHP is centered around parish renewal weekends and stresses a clear focus on the Gospel. It allows parish renewal in furthering conversion and community, ministry and prayer, healing and holiness, spiritual growth and gospel service. CRHP emphasizes continued growth in Christian life during our daily contacts with others and offers an excellent opportunity to meet other parishioners.

#### What happens on the weekend?

The weekend enables you to hear and discuss how Catholics function in our modern, complex, fast-paced society. The renewal weekend provides an atmosphere of individual spiritual growth through prayer and personal reflection. You can share conversations and thoughts (as much or as little as you desire) with others during the weekend who also encounter the many demands of everyday life presented by family, jobs and society. Mass will be celebrated during the weekend and the opportunity for reconciliation will be provided.

### When and where is the weekend held?

The weekend is held at Blessed Trinity School and begins at 8 a.m. on Saturday and ends approximately at 5 p.m. on Sunday. Beds and all meals will be provided.

A team comprised of a parish priest and people who have attended previous weekends conduct the weekend. There are four CRHP weekends per year, two for men and two for women. Each weekend is limited to 36 participants, minimum age 20. Casual and comfortable clothing is

appropriate for the weekend.
